IGAD Executive Secretary sends message of congratulations to Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed on receiving the Nobel Peace Prize 2019

Oct. 11, 2019 (DJIBOUTI, Djibouti): The Executive Secretary of IGAD Amb (Eng) Mahboub Maalim sent a message of heart-felt congratulations to Prime Minister of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia H.E. Dr. Abiy Ahmed on receiving the prestigious Nobel Peace Prize for 2019.

Amb. Maalim described the award as very well-deserved, and a source of great pride not only for Ethiopia and the IGAD region but for the African continent. 'It was particularly a proud moment for the IGAD region given Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed's role as Chairperson of IGAD', he stated.
